## MATERIALS

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Introduce the exercise to the class, and present the objective and outcome.
- Present the following video to the class and ask them to write down all the reasons why the victim was cyberbullied: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KVTzGnr3KZU</u> (2 minutes 45 seconds)
- 3. Discuss the responses and encourage them to think of other reasons why cyberbullying may occur. Here are some suggestions:
  - Vulnerability, lack of empathy from the cyberbully, retaliation, anonymity, family problems, jealousy.
- 4. End the exercise by telling the students that although there may be reasons for why an episode of cyberbullying started, this is still not acceptable.
